San Benito County Chamber of Commerce Parade Rules

Parade Entry Number

- Entry numbers will be available the day of the Parade only at the following locations and times:

Chamber Office	9:00 am to 5:00 pm
High School northern parking lot	3:00 pm to 5:30 pm
- Parade Entry Numbers correspond to numbers painted on Monterey Street and Palmtag Drive.
- Entry numbers must be displayed on the **left side** (driver's side) of the entry.

Parade Line-up

- Parade Line-up begins at 4:30pm
- Line-up facing south on Monterey Street and east on Palmtag Drive according to your Parade entry number.
- Parade Entries must be in position by 5:45 pm
- Units not in position will be placed at the end of the Parade.

Parade Route

- The Parade will begin at 6:00 pm
- The Parade runs north on San Benito Street from Palmtag Drive. Turn left on Fifth Street and then left on Monterey Street.
- All Parade units must complete the Parade route. No one is to dismount or disembark at any time.
- Each Parade unit may perform **one** routine for the Judges.
- Marshals will be stationed along the Parade route and must be obeyed.

Miscellaneous

- No objects, including candy, samples, or literature may be **thrown** or **distributed** from your unit. Any units disregarding this rule will be disqualified from the prizes.
- Any person who teases, taunts, throws objects, makes noises, or sudden movement at the animal participants of the parade will be disqualified.
- Amplified equipment must maintain a volume which will not hinder other units.
- No alcoholic beverages may be consumed or displayed by parade participants.
- **Stallions are not allowed in the parade.**

For the safety of all involved, anyone found in violation of the Parade Rules will not be allowed to participate in the Saddle Horse Parade the following year.

Liability

- In the event there are any injuries associated with a violation of these rules, you will be held personally liable.
